## Blood Draw

Our May meeting/activity will be a "Blood Draw" for the English Springer Spaniel Field Trial Association Foundation DNA Bank.

The meeting will be held on Saturday, May 12 at the offices of Dr. Paul Scherlie in Clackamas, OR. A Technician will be available from 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. The meeting will follow at 2:00 p.m.

We are gathering *information and blood samples* for DNA Research at the University of Missouri. **Bring your dogs** and encourage families with whom you've placed puppies or dogs to attend also.

We are drawing blood from a wide variety of Springer families, both healthy and/or those affected with heritable problems. The samples you provide will allow researchers to continue discovering the genes controlling traits in our breed, and in dogs in general. As the canine genome is mapped, breeders will have an unprecedented opportunity to identify and avoid producing disease, and concentrate on positive advances in their breeding programs.

It is of utmost importance that the information you provide with the samples is as complete and accurate

as possible. The presence of disease, unusual or "undesirable" characteristics should be revealed to the researchers wherever they have been identified. Blood samples from dogs who appear unaffected by problems like those listed on the questionnaire may be moved into a specific area of the study by the breeder or owner if problems arise at a later time.

Information on specific, individual dogs will not be revealed — results of the research will identify what markers have been found, but not the names of those who submitted the samples where a characteristic was located, nor which individual dogs show affected or carrier status for any given condition. Information provided will be kept strictly confidential. As the research produces results, participants may request information on the genetic status of their dog(s).

Complete families are critical to locating specific genes and markers. Wherever possible, submit samples from all siblings, both parents, and all available grandparents.

### Breeders

Begin by gathering the pedigree, litter information, and litter list(s) for each family you plan to submit. You will need a correctly formatted (sire on top, dam on the bottom), typed

or computer-generated pedigree (3- to 5-generation) of the litter. Provide copies of the pedigree for each individual dog sampled. The pedigree will connect each sample you submit to the family it comes from. On a spare copy of the pedigree you may want to mark (for yourself) who is alive and sampled, not sampled, and those no longer living, to keep track of who you need to get samples from. As stated before, entire families will give the best chance at finding specific genes — do your best to include all living family members.

### Individuals

You will need to provide the dog's AKC registration number. Contact your breeder or Jan Martin for a pedigree. The club will have the forms for submission at the blood draw but will not be able to generate a pedigree on site. The Individual Dog Questionnaire should accompany each sample, along with the marked pedigree that will tie in with the family information sent. We will provide copies of the sample handling and individual dog forms as needed for all samples to be submitted, or you can fill them out at home and bring them.

Thank you for participating. You are contributing to the betterment of future generations.

## Success Stories

Rescue continues to rock! Starting with Rocky, a b/w neutered boy who first came to our attention last summer. We had a great home for him, but his family changed its mind and signed up for a training class. However, their busy life kept getting in the way, Rocky got older and so lonely that he was chewing on the siding of the house during the 12 hours a day he was alone in the yard!

Rocky's an active guy who is good with toddlers, cats, and other dogs. He went home to the Vincent family in Salem with young kids and doggie experience. New mom is home much more, and his new kid-friends will play ball with him and enjoy him!

Riley is a 7 month old English Springer, Cavalier cross. He is small and tri-colored. His tail is undocked. He is a handsome boy, and has a wonderful happy-go-lucky temperament. He was surrendered to Cavalier Rescue for anticipated high maintenance costs associated with his aller-

gies. His former owner bought him out of a local newspaper as a Cavalier.
