4. Advance the interest of the breed by practicing and encouraging sportsmanlike competition at dog shows, obedience trials, field activities, tracking and hunting tests, and all activities in which the breed may become involved.
5. Protect the breed by never selling puppies or grown dogs to commercial outlets and never selling puppies in litter lots.
